DUI vs BUI

Driving Under the Influence:

Charge: Misdemeanor (No Injuries)
Felony (Injuries or Death)

Fine: \$1,000 (No Injuries)
\$5,000+ (Injuries or Death)

Jail Time: 3+ Months County Jail (No Injuries & 1st offense)
0-10 Years (Injuries or Death)

Boating Under the Influence:

Charge: Misdemeanor (No Injuries)
Felony (Injuries or Death)

Fine: \$1,000 (No Injuries)
\$5,000+ (Injuries or Death)

Jail Time: 1 year County Jail (No Injuries)
10+ Years (Injuries or Death)

CHECK OUT THIS STAT

Between 2005 and 2009 there were over 2,319 motor vehicle related deaths over Labor Day weekend. Nearly 40% of those deaths were alcohol related.

All contain the same amount of alcohol

12 OZ of beer



1.5 OZ of liquor



5 OZ of wine
